The Arc of Riverside County is committed to securing for all people with mental retardation and other developmental disabilities, in partnership with their families, legal guardians or conservators the opportunity to choose and realize their goals of where and how they learn, live, work and play.

The Arc of Riverside County is further committed to reducing the incidence and limiting the consequence of mental retardation through education, research, advocacy and the support of families, friends and community.

## Work Activities

Advance Enterprises is a vocational program designed to provide employment opportunities for adults with intellectual disabilities. This program provides training opportunities in work-related skills that enhance employability needed in the current labor market. In a factory setting, through subcontracted work from regional businesses, we perform a variety of jobs and tasks including packaging and assembly, skin packaging, shrink wrapping, heat sealing, collating and sorting, decaling and labeling, small parts assembly, and much more.

Advance Enterprises, a division of The Arc of Riverside County, has two locations—one in Riverside and another in Beaumont—to better serve you.

Plus, we even offer pick-up and delivery service, adding to the value Advance Enterprises can offer your business.

## Support Work

As part of our objective to help individuals with developmental disabilities achieve their full potential in the community, The Arc of Riverside County, in cooperation with local industry and community groups, develops employment opportunities in the competitive world of work.

Individuals and work teams, with support from a full-time Job Coach or supervisor, are employed by local companies in work settings ranging from food services opportunities to janitorial and grounds maintenance services.

## Adult Development Centers

The Riverside Resource Center, Brockton Resource Center, Moreno Valley Resource Center and Ray Strebe Resource Center cater to adults with severe intellectual disabilities. At our resource centers, the needs of the individual are of the highest priority, and a low program attendee-to-staff ratio ensures appropriate one-on-one instruction.

## Training includes the following areas:

Self-help skills  
Daily living activities  
Vocational Skills  
Community awareness  
Social interaction skills

## Entrance to The Arc of Riverside County Programs

Following are the criteria which will determine an individual's eligibility for The Arc of Riverside County's programs:

- Developmentally disabled with a primary diagnosis of mental retardation
- At least 18 years of age
- Free from behavioral and medical conditions which pose a hazard to self, others and/or agency property
- Able to tolerate a 7-hour program day
- Able to administer to personal needs
- Assessed as appropriate for one of the programs

In addition, the individuals should be referred by the Inland Regional Center.
